Derbyniwyd cofnodion cyfarfod **11 Gorffennaf 2023** fel rhai cywir, Wil Edwards yn cynnig a Geraint Thomas yn eilio.

## Materion yn codi:

**Loriau yng Nghwm Penmachno:** Adroddwyd bod Llywodraeth Cymru wedi cael cais i awdurdodi camau i gomisiynu ymgynghorydd er mwyn ceisio drafftio arwyddion newydd ar gyfer yr A5. Byddai'n rhaid gosod yr arwyddion yn ystod mis Hydref neu fis Tachwedd. Adroddwyd bod lori, ym mis Awst, wedi cyrraedd Cwm Penmachno yn ceisio cyrraedd Porthmadog a'r lori wedi difrodi wal.

**WiFi Cymunedol:** Adroddwyd bod 571 o ddyfeisiau wedi cysylltu dros y mis blaenorol ac roedd y Diwrnod Hwyl ddiweddar yn y pentref yn uchafbwynt. Diolchwyd i'r Clerc a'i ŵr am wirfoddoli eu hamser a gwneud y gwaith gosod.

**Gwesty'r Machno:** Adroddwyd bod y safle wedi ei dacluso ychydig ond mae nifer o gerbydau yn parhau ar y safle.

**Llys Meddyg:** Adroddwyd bod y cyfarfod safle diweddar gydag Awdurdod y Parc a'r Cyngor Sir wedi bod yn gynhyrchiol iawn. Roedd Awdurdod y Parc wedi ysgrifennu at y tirlfeddiannwr.

**Sgipiau:** Adroddwyd bod y Cyngor Sir, er gwaethaf cael cyfarwyddiadau clir, wedi anfon sgip i'r pentref anghywir ym mis Awst. Ym mis Medi, roedd bagiau o rwbel wedi eu gadael ar gyfer y sgip yng Nghwm Penmachno ac mae'n bosib y bydd y Cyngor Cymuned yn cael bil. Penderfynwyd rhoi gwybod i drigolion gan ddefnyddio'r cyfryngau cymdeithasol.

**Toiledau Cyhoeddus:** Adroddwyd bod y Clerc wedi cwrdd â'r person sy'n berchen ar y tir y tu ôl i'r toiledau. Mae'n hapus i ffos gael ei chloddio i drwsio'r broblem lleithder.

Cadarnhawyd y bydd y cyflenwad trydan yn symud o e-on i British Gas.

Adroddwyd y bydd £222 yn cael ei dalu i'r Cyngor am ynni a gynhyrchir gan y Paneli Solar yn ystod y flwyddyn ddiwethaf.

## Confirmation of the minutes

The minutes of the **11 July 2023** meeting were accepted as a true record, proposed by Wil Edwards and seconded by Geraint Thomas.

## Matters arising:

**Lorries in Cwm Penmachno:** It was reported that the Welsh Government has been asked to authorise steps to commission a consultant to try to draft new signs for the A5. The signs would have to be installed during October or November. It was reported that, in August, a lorry had arrived in Cwm Penmachno trying to get to Porthmadog and had damaged a wall.

**Community WiFi:** It was reported that, over the previous month, 571 devices had connected with the recent Fun Day in the village being a highlight. The Clerk and his husband were thanked for volunteering their time and carrying out the installation work.

**Machno Inn:** It was reported that the site had been tidied up a little but a number of vehicles remain on the site.

**Llys Meddyg:** It was reported that the recent site meeting with the Park Authority and the County Council had been very productive. The Park Authority had written to the landowner.

**Skips:** It was reported that, despite clear instructions, the County Council had sent a skip to the wrong village in August. In September, bags of rubble had been left for the skip in Cwm Penmachno and it is possible that the Community Council will be billed. It was decided to inform residents using social media.

**Public Toilets:** It was reported that the Clerk had met the person who owns the land behind the toilets. He is happy for a trench to be dug to fix the damp problem.

It was confirmed that the electricity supply will move from e-on to British Gas.

It was reported that £222 will be paid to the Council for energy generated by the Solar Panels in the last year.

Following a successful grant application, it was reported that the company installing the new contactless entry system are now working with the Clerk.

**Ysgwyfrith:** Penderfynwyd cysylltu â'r Ymddiriedolaeth Genedlaethol a mynegi siom bod yr eiddo yn dal heb denant.

**Ysgwyfrith:** It was decided to contact the National Trust and express disappointment that the property is still without a tenant.

**Posterï wedi'u lamineiddio:** Adroddwyd bod y gymuned yng Nghwm wedi penderfynu prynu dau hysbysfwrdd.

**Laminated Posters:** It was reported that the community in Cwm had decided to purchase two noticeboards.

**Dannedd y Ddraig:** Adroddwyd y bydd y terfyn cyflymder yn gostwng i 20mya ar 17 Medi a'r gobaith oedd bod y marciau ffordd newydd yn helpu i arafu traffig ar y ffordd i mewn i Benmachno. Trafodwyd opsiynau eraill gan gynnwys Gwarchod Cyflymder Cymunedol. Penderfynwyd dod o hyd i bris am arwydd electronig.

**Dragon's Teeth:** It was hoped that the new road markings are helping to slow traffic on the way into Penmachno. Other options were discussed including Community Speed Watch. It was decided to find out the price for an electronic sign.

**Ci Strae:** Adroddwyd bod y landlord a'r Cyngor Sir wedi ysgrifennu at berchennog y ci. Roedd dwy gŵyn arall wedi dod i mewn a bydd y Cyngor Sir yn cynyddu patrolau yn yr ardal.

**Stray Dog:** It was reported that the landlord and the County Council had written to the owner of the dog. Two further complaints had been received and the County Council will be increasing patrols in the area.

**Trelar:** Adroddwyd bod y trelar yn dal i barcio yng Nghwm Penmachno. Bydd y Cyngorydd Sir yn codi'r pwnc gyda'r adran ffyrdd.

**Trailer:** It was reported that the trailer was still parked in Cwm Penmachno. The County Councillor will raise the subject with the highways department.

**Public Footpaths:** It was decided to contact the contractor to make sure he is happy to carry on maintaining the paths.

It was decided to report three other footpath problems:

No. 15: a broken stile

No. 64: dangerous access from the road

No. 65: a section of the path is closed despite clear signage, stiles and a footbridge.

**The Waen Car Park:** It was decided to contact Cartrefi Conwy to report the pot holes and remind them to cut the hedge. It was reported that the gate adjoining Llewelyn Street has broken.

**Large Shed:** It was noted that a large shed has been erected and is visible from the road to Cwm. It was decided to check the regulations with the Park Authority.

**Traws Eryri:** Following the introduction of the new cycle route, it was decided to contact Cycling UK to let them know about the facilities available to visitors in Penmachno.

**Policies, data security and GDPR:** With the introduction of Community Wifi and the Council doing more of its work digitally, it was decided to enquire about
